This is an opportunity for radiology trainees, foundation doctors and medical students to pitch research or audit ideas to a multi-disciplinary panel.

The idea is to come up with an IR-related research or audit idea that could be taken forward through the UK National Interventional Radiology Trainee Research (UNITE) network.

The format of the virtual pitch will be:

- 90 second 'elevator style' video pitch recorded on zoom
- Optional: Using a maximum of 1 powerpoint slide
- Cover the clinical question being answered/ topic addressed, clinical relevance/ rationale for project and brief summary of methods on how the project could be conducted and any required resources

Marking Team:

All submissions will be scored by members of the UNITE collaborative. The 5 top scoring submissions will be invited to present an extended 5 minute presentation at the 'Project Pitch Competition Finalists – Prize session' during the IR Research Day event.

Marking Assessment Criteria:

- 1. Impact What impact will the project have on patients, the public and/or people working in healthcare?
- 2. Innovation Is the idea novel? Will the study add to the existing body of knowledge?
- 3. Feasibility Is the proposed study feasible and deliverable?
- 4. Resource What resources/ funding is required? Are the proposed costs/ required resources of the research reasonable and commensurate with the proposed work involved?
- 5. Presentation style

The winning presentation will be awarded with an NIHR prize at the awards ceremony. The winning project team can take their idea forward and develop it with the help of the UNITE network.
